

## **The Classrooms**

Our elementary classrooms each serve up to 25 students and are staffed by two full-time employees. Each classroom has a *lead teacher*, who is primarily responsible for administering the curriculum and creating a warm, nurturing, safe, and loving environment—one where self-confidence is strengthened, independence is encouraged, and individuality is respected.

Working alongside the lead teacher is a *classroom assistant*, whose main role is to care for the individual needs of students and to help the teacher foster a setting where children can grow physically, emotionally, and intellectually.

At WLCA, both the teacher and the assistant—along with all school employees—are expected to have a personal relationship with God and be active participants in their church ministries. All staff members hold CPR, First Aid, and AED certifications. Teachers must have a college degree, and assistants must have prior experience working with children in a large group or classroom setting.

Our curriculum covers all core subjects: English, Math, Science, History, Spelling, and Bible. Specialty classes such as Art, Computers, and Chapel are held in designated areas outside the classroom. While our school offers choir and school-wide performances, music is not part of the daily classroom schedule.
