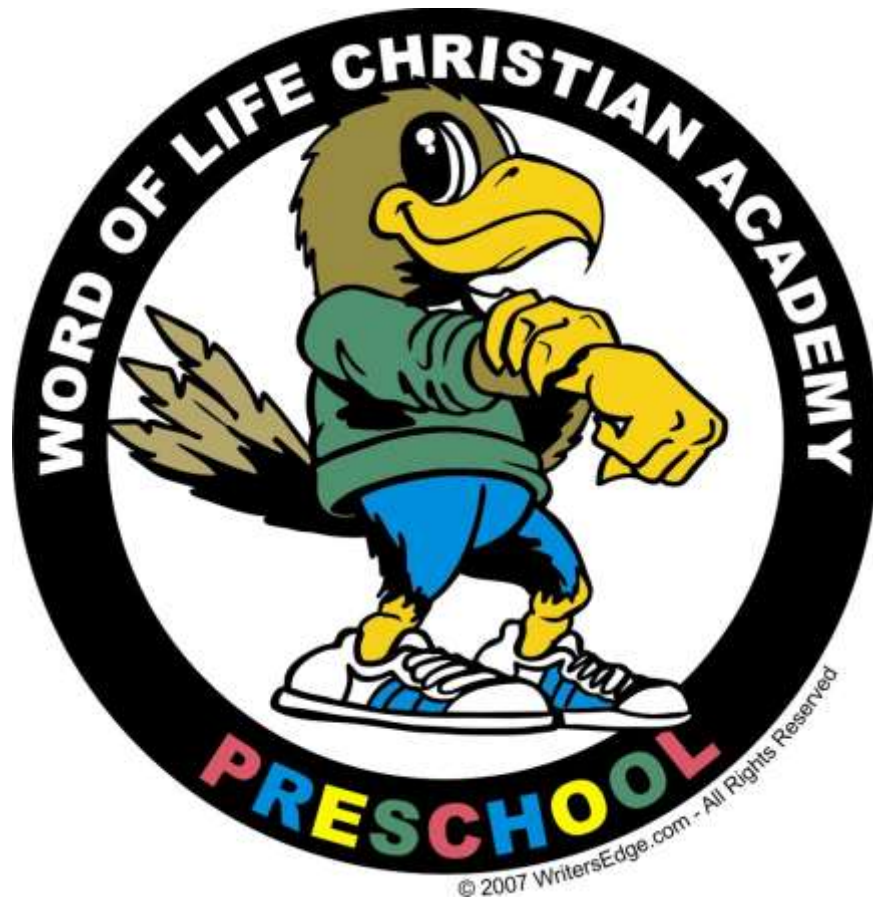

2026-2027 Non-optional Fees and Tuition Rates

Registration

An annual non-refundable reservation deposit of \$200.00 is due at the time of registration. This deposit holds your child's space until the first day of school 2026 and pays for all of your child's curriculum cost, spirit shirt, yearbook and Field Day Lunch. If you do not pay tuition by the end of the first week of school 2026 your space will be given to the next person on the waiting list.

First Responders and Military

Tuition is paid weekly. The first payment is due on the first day of school in 2026. All weekly payments must be paid by your first scheduled day of each week. A \$5.00 late fee will be added to your account for each business day that tuition is not paid. If you have more than one child enrolled in the pre-school, the oldest child will be at full price, the second child will receive a 5% discount, and the third child or more will receive a 10% discount. *Please note that the tither discount applies to Word of Life Christian Center church members only.*

Discounts

- Active Duty Military-10% (must be a custodial parent and present active duty military ID during enrollment)
- Full-Time First Responders-10% (Active Law Enforcement, Fire Fighter, EMT) (must be a custodial parent and present a current badge during enrollment)
- Multi Child-2 or more students enrolled in pre-school, 1st child is regular price, 2nd child receives 5% off, three or more receive 10% discount

Graduation Fee

\$50 added to your account at the time of registration (due December 1st) and includes:

- Keepsake cap-n-gown
- 2026 tassel
- Graduation Diploma
- Cupcake reception for graduates, family, and friends

Hours of Operation

Our hours of operation are Monday through Friday, from 6:30 am to 6:00 pm.

If your child is enrolled in a full-day program, you may bring them to school at any time between the above hours. If your child is enrolled for five half days, a half day is anytime between 6:30 am and 12 noon or 12 noon and 6:00 pm. Half-day children dropped off before 6:30 am or 12noon will be charged \$1.00 per minute per child. Children picked up after 12noon or after 6:00 pm will be charged \$1.00 per minute per child. Any parent who does not sign their child in or out will be charged \$5 each time, for each child.

Supply List

Please provide one extra complete set of clothing for your child. One complete set includes a shirt, pants, underwear and socks. Write your child's **name or initials** on the clothing. All items must be able to fit into a large zip lock bag, labeled with the student's name and must be changed seasonally. Lunch boxes, water bottles and book bags **must be labeled** as well. One Homework Folder with your child's name Written on it.

Also, provide one small blanket and one small pillow to be used for naptime. These items must also be labeled with the student's name and be able to fit into their individual cubbie. Both items should be taken home weekly for cleaning. *Please no favorite, bed-sized, pillows, and blankets.*

Most importantly, please bring a sack lunch that does not require heating or refrigeration, as we do not have access to a microwave, and our refrigerator is full of daily snacks, milk, and party items. ***No Room for Lunches!*** In addition, keep in mind that lunches should be balanced daily with healthy grains, proteins, fruits, and vegetables. Soda, candy, and other sugary snacks will be returned to the lunch bags. And for everyone's safety, glass bottles and containers are prohibited.

Due to COVID-19, we have been mandated by the Southern Nevada Health District to deactivate all water fountains. Please provide your child with a reusable water bottle daily (filled with water, NOT juice).
